

## KING PHILIP MUSIC PROGRAM CO-CURRICULA FEES & BAND CAMP ORIENTATION PACKET

Dear Parent/Guardian and Student:

During the last several years, discussion has occurred over the initiation of fees for students who participate in co-curricular music programs. Fees were instituted in 2008. The 2011 - 2012 academic year will be the fourth year of this system.

The basis for the proposal is an understanding that the school district is committed to excellence in every program that it sponsors. That commitment to excellence assumes district responsibility to define the programs that it wants and the level of excellence it expects. With this commitment also comes responsibility to monetarily support the programs.

The proposal assumes a three year plan on the part of the district to increase its funding for the co-curricular music programs. The basis of the recommended fee structure for co-curricular music is the current ratio of district support and fees for athletics. The district's budget for athletics is supported through fees (30%) and through district funding (70%). The district's support for the co-curricular music program was 30% of the music program's current budget. The sources of the remaining 70% were the King Philip Music Association and family out-of-pocket support. The intention of this proposal is to commit the district to a similar funding ratio for the co-curricular music program, to reduce reliance on the King Philip Music Association to fund the program, and to reduce family out-of-pocket expenses where possible.

The current goal is for the district to increase its funding of the co-curricular music program to 70%. This increase in funding will occur over three fiscal years. The FY2010 budget included \$27,000 towards this funding plan. Though the King Philip Music Association will continue its fundraising efforts, it is hoped fewer funds will be needed to support the co-curricular music program, as currently defined. Such trips to Dayton and the WGI world championships, and Giants Stadium for the marching band, have been figured into the cost of operating the program.

The attached fee structure provides support for the 30% goal. The fees are structured differently than the athletic program. The athletic program has a flat fee for all teams because the programs are defined by league and MIAA schedules. Each music program, however, has unique opportunities to participate in local, regional, and national settings. Therefore, the recommendation includes a separate fee structure for each music activity. **Please note that band camp is not included in this proposal. It remains separate from the operating costs of the marching band co-curricular program. Please also note that the co-curricular fees for next year have not been determined as of this time. Every effort is being made to keep these fees as close as possible to this past year's fees with nominal increases. As soon as the school determines fees, this will be made known and public.**

It is important to note that the initiation of fees is one that replaces trip fees previously borne by the families of the participants in the five co-curricula groups at the high school. Those trip fees were greater than the user fees adopted by the school committee. This represents an immediate reduction in cost to families for students in three of the five groups.

Notwithstanding the increase of the districts commitment and the initiation of fees, the KPMA will continue to face financial responsibilities to insure the various co-curricula programs are maintained at their current levels of funding, thus, maintaining a nationally based standard of excellence. Thus, it is very important that parents and families continue to be involved in the fundraising activities of the KPMA.

On the next page is a breakdown of the fee structure and its comparison to the current year. Next year's fees have not been determined as of this time, but increases will be very small. The budget of the KPMA will remain aggressive to not only back up the funding, but to also offer more opportunities as they develop. The KPMA executive board has embraced this new arrangement.

**DISCIPLINE STANDARD GUIDELINES**

The King Philip Regional High School Music Program has long enjoyed a reputation for musical excellence and worthy educational achievements. Because of our appearances at music conferences and festivals, our M.M.E.A. ratings, our own local concerts, as well as numerous King Philip students who appear at district, state, and national festivals; audiences, music conductors, educators, and students from other schools have come to expect exceptionally high levels of musical performance and personal behavior from the King Philip performing groups. The countless but productive hours, which have brought about this high level of proficiency, are indicative of the commitment the students and faculty bring to their work. The advancement of the music program at King Philip has been both exciting and rewarding, and the culmination of the development is demonstrated by the Senior High Performing Arts Program.

We wish to maintain these worthy traditions while increasing the musical sensitivity and character growth of our students through cooperative effort, self-discipline, responsibility, patience, attention to detail, and the desire for perfection. A proper attitude and a strong concept of responsibility to one's self and to the group are necessary to achieve these indispensable values. We believe that each student, through his or her full participation in the King Philip Regional School District Music Program, will have the opportunity to experience and achieve better things throughout their lifetime.

It is in the spirit of cooperation that I ask each parent or guardian of a participating student, as well as the students themselves, to read the following disciplinary objectives in order that the performing groups continue to project the high standard of discipline and performance which is associated with our music program. Please sign and date the Discipline Standard Guidelines form included in this packet to indicate that you have read, understand and accept these guidelines:

- Attendance at rehearsals and performances is mandatory; but in the event of an emergency or sudden illness that would cause absence from a rehearsal or performance and in order to facilitate performance and organization matters, the involved student must have his or her parent call the respective teacher at least one hour prior to the rehearsal or performance.
- A yearly calendar will be issued to all participating students at the beginning of each semester. An attempt will be made for additions and changes to this calendar to be posted on the bulletin board in the band room at least one week prior to an event. The calendar can also be found at [www.kingphilip.org/kphigh/music/kpmusichomepage.html](http://www.kingphilip.org/kphigh/music/kpmusichomepage.html). Students are expected to plan their schedules as to avoid conflicting dates. Only under unforeseen circumstances will a student be excused from a rehearsal or performance. If a student feels that he or she has a valid excuse for being absent from a scheduled event, a written parental explanation must be given to the respective teacher at least one week prior to the date in question (not inclusive of emergencies). If the absence of the individual is considered detrimental to the performing group, the request will be denied and the student will be notified as soon as possible. Disregard for these understandings will result in disciplinary action or dismissal from the group. Your assistance and cooperation will serve as an integral part of the success of the performing groups. Thank you for your continued cooperation and support of the King Philip Regional School District Music Program.
