Varsity Baseball – KP Regional High School - 201 Franklin Street, Wrentham, MA 02093

From the north (Boston)

Take Route 128 South to Route 95 South to Route 1 South - Wrentham exit (Exit 9)

Continue on Route 1 South past 2 traffic lights, Foxboro Stadium, Lafayette House Restaurant (about 3 miles) to Route 140

At bottom of exit ramp, turn left. Stay on Route 140 through the center of the town

After the set of lights, school is approximately 1/4 mile on the left

From the south (Rhode Island)

Take Route 95 North to Route 495 North. Follow Route 495 to the second Wrentham exit (Exit 15)

This is the Wrentham/Plainville exit - Route 1A. At the bottom of the exit ramp, turn right

Follow route 1A to the center of Wrentham At the traffic light, turn left onto Route 140

School is approximately 1/4 mile on the left

From the West

Take Route 495 South to King Street exit (Exit 16). At the bottom of exit ramp, turn left

Follow King Street (2 1/2 miles) and take a right onto Route 140 and follow it for about 4-5 miles

King Philip Regional High School will be on your right

JV Baseball – William A. Rice Recreation Complex -

From 95 (coming from Boston, Cambridge, Braintree, Dorchester...)

Take exit 9 (Foxboro Stadium). Take Route 1 South. After passing Foxboro Stadium (on your left), at the first light take right onto Pine Street. Follow Pine Street 1/4 mile, at T Junction bear right onto Pine Street/Route 115. Travel on Pine Street/115 for 1/2 mile. Take Left onto Route 1A South. Travel on Rt. 1A South for ~1.5 miles and take a right onto North Street. Follow North street ~1/4 mile and take Left onto Emerald Street. Field will be on the right.

From 495 (Rhode Island, Western MA...)

Take exit for Route 1A North. Go ~3 miles and take left onto North Street. Follow North street ~1/4 mile and take Left onto Emerald Street. Field will be on the right

From the north (Boston)

Take Route 128 South to Route 95 South to Route 1 South - Wrentham exit (Exit 9)

Continue on Route 1 South past 2 traffic lights, Foxboro Stadium,

Lafayette House Restaurant (about 3 miles) to Route 140

At bottom of exit ramp, turn left. Stay on Route 140 through the center of the town

After the set of lights, go about 1/4 mile until the road forks and take the right (straight) fork onto Shears St. (Rte. 140 is the left fork). Continue on Shears St. about 2 miles and go left onto Union Street and travel

about 1/4 mile and then turn left onto King Street. Go up the hill 1/4 mile and at the top turn

Right into entrance of the school.

From the south (Rhode Island)

Take Route 95 North to Route 495 North. Follow Route 495 to the second Wrentham exit (Exit 15)
This is the Wrentham/Plainville exit - Route 1A. At the bottom of the exit ramp, turn right
Follow route 1A to the center of Wrentham. At the traffic light, turn left onto Route 140
Go about 1/4 mile until the road forks and take the right (straight) fork onto Shears St. (Rte. 140 is the left fork). Continue on Shears St. about 2 miles and go left onto Union Street and go about 1/4 mile and then turn left onto King Street. Go up the hill 1/4 mile and at the top turn right into entrance of the school.

From the West

Take Route 495 South to King Street exit (Exit 16). At the bottom of exit ramp, turn left
Follow King Street (2 1/2 miles) and take a right onto Route 140 and follow it for about 4-5 miles (King Philip Regional High School will be on your right). Take a left opposite the high school entrance and then immediate left onto Shears Street. Continue on Shears St. about 2 miles and go left onto Union Street and go about 1/4 mile and then turn left onto King Street. Go up the hill 1/4 mile and at the top turn right into entrance of the school.

Softball (All Levels) – PAL Fields, George St. – Plainville**From the North:**

Route 95 South to Route 495 North to Route 1 South (Exit 14 B) North Attleboro *

From the South:

Route 95 North to Route 495 North to Route 1 South (Exit 14 B) North Attleboro *

Alternate from the South:

Route 1 North into Plainville. Continue through set of lights at Route 106.

Take your next left onto George Street (about 3/10 mile from Route 106). Follow George Street for 1/2 mile. The complex will be on your right.

From the Southeast:

Route 195 to Route 24 North to Route 495 North to Route 1 South (Exit 14 B) North Attleboro *

From the East:

Route 495 North to Route 1 South (Exit 14 B) North Attleboro *

From the West:

Route 495 South to Route 1 South (Exit 14 B) North Attleboro *

* When you get to Route 1 South you will come to a set of lights (Route 152). Continue on Route 1 for 1 and 1/10 miles.

At this point George Street will be on your right. Take a right onto George Street and follow for 1/2 mile. The complex will be on your right.

Please note: There is no on street parking allowed on the opposite side of the street from the complex. Police will ticket

From the north (Boston)

Take Route 128 South to Route 95 South to Route 1 South - Wrentham exit (Exit 9)
Continue on Route 1 South past 2 traffic lights, Foxboro Stadium, Lafayette House Restaurant (about 3 miles) to Route 140
At bottom of exit ramp, turn left. Stay on Route 140 through the center of the town
After the set of lights, school is approximately 1/4 mile on the left

From the south (Rhode Island)

Take Route 95 North to Route 495 North. Follow Route 495 to the second Wrentham exit (Exit 15)

Follow King Street (2 1/2 miles) and take a right onto Route 140 and follow it for about 4-5 miles
King Philip Regional High School will be on your right
