



## Actions taken to optimize safety during COVID-19

### Summer 2020

- New hands-free towel dispensers and trash barrels in all high school bathrooms.
- Dividers installed between every bathroom sink, and additional soap dispensers added to accompany every sink.
- Faucets replaced or adjusted at both buildings to assure run times meet CDC recommendations for hand washing.
- Hand sanitizer stations installed in hallways outside bathrooms.
- Portable, free-standing hand sanitizer units will be placed at main entry and exit points in both buildings.
- All classroom windows and doors function properly and can be opened during the school day for additional ventilation.
- HVAC systems undergo annual preventive maintenance every summer. All system functions are tested and inspected to achieve ideal operational output. Air filters replaced three times per year.
- Completed thorough inspection of all HVAC ductwork inside the high school, and professionally cleaned all high-traffic areas. This was second phase of this project, after inspecting and cleaning the auditorium, main office suite, guidance office suite, library, and science classrooms in Summer 2019.
- Plexiglass safety barriers added to several areas through both buildings: main offices, secretaries, guidance secretaries, nurse offices, special education offices, school psychologists, and libraries. Safety shields for classroom teachers and guidance offices are ordered and on the way.
- Both buildings had all carpets professionally cleaned and disinfected.
- The district has purchased a total of six electrostatic sprayers to effectively and efficiently disinfect both buildings daily.
- All classrooms will be provided with an inventory of personal protective equipment (PPE) including disposable masks, gloves, glasses or goggles, gowns, disinfectant wipes, roll towels, and hand sanitizer. Individual employees will be provided their own face shield if desired. These products will be available in classrooms for distribution as needed, and a 12-week supply is on hand.
