What is the Massachusetts Rehabilitation Commission?

The Massachusetts Rehabilitation Commission is the public agency that provides Vocational Rehabilitation Services!!!

What is Vocational Rehabilitation?

Vocational Rehabilitation is a comprehensive sequence of individualized services developed with a professional counselor to increase an individual's ability to secure meaningful employment

Who Is Eligible?

Individuals who have a disabling condition that has prevented them from securing or maintaining a job consistent with their abilities

What Services Are Available?

Guidance and Counseling

To explore vocational skills, aptitudes, interests and realistic job goals

Skill Training and Education

At vocational schools, colleges, community facilities and on-the-job

Assistive Technology and Rehabilitation Engineering

For necessary accommodations

Restorative Equipment and Treatment

Not covered by insurance

Vehicle and Housing Modification

Needed to get to and from work

Job Search and Follow-up Assistance

Resumes, cover letters, job search assistance, job seeking skills, networking and job coaching

What Happens At MRC?

Eligible individuals meet with a Vocational Rehabilitation Counselor for assessment and counseling to develop an individualized employment plan (a step by step approach of what you need to get a job!)

What does it cost?

Financial assistance to fund the plan is determined by need and availability of funds
