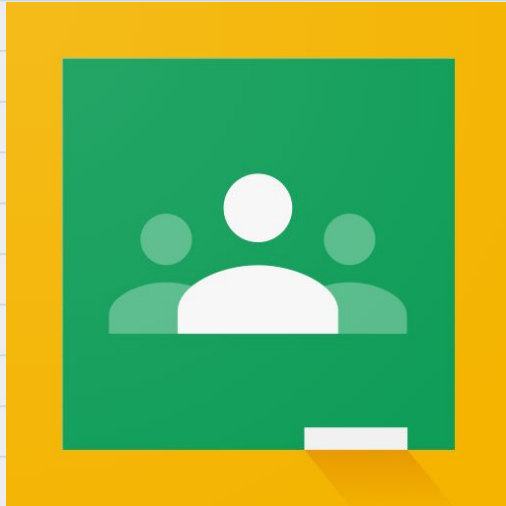
- REPRESENTS ENTIRE SCHOOL

- DO, be mindful of yourself and others when walking to and from classes


