District Profile:

Established in 1957, and named in honor of the Wampanoag sachem Metacom, the King Philip Regional School District proudly serves secondary students in the towns of Norfolk, Plainville, and Wrentham, Massachusetts. The regional middle school, located in Norfolk, serves grades 7 and 8, while the regional high school, housed in Wrentham, serves grades 9 through 12. Each of the three towns maintains its own PK6 public school systems

King Philip sponsors numerous championship winning teams across nearly 30 varsity sports, and its widely recognized music program has received an abundance of awards over the years. Dozens of student organizations are active between the two schools, including DECA, Model UN, Student Councils, and various Honor Societies.
