- Uphold 3.25 Term GPA*
- Be enrolled or planning to enroll as a full-time student (at least 12 credits) for next semester
- Be a member of Picerne Family Foundation closed Facebook group
- Submit semi-annual update to picernefoundation@picernerri.com by **September 1 & March 1** for the Foundation to Review that includes:
 1. Student Semester Update Form
 2. Complete Transcript, including semester grades, semester GPA, cumulative GPA, and next semester enrollment

*Under exceptional circumstances, accompanied with a detailed explanation, a GPA of below 3.25 might be acceptable.

PICERNE FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP EVENTS
