KPSA Scholarship Instructions:

1. Applicant must have played or refereed a minimum of four seasons with King Philip Soccer Association (KPSA). KPSA encompasses 7th and 8th grade fall and spring soccer as well as High School spring soccer. Applicant must have refereed, center or assistant, at least 5 games in a given season for it to count toward your 4 seasons with KPSA.
2. Applicant should be able to name their coach for each of the seasons played on their application. Applicants that played more than four seasons may be given greater consideration in this regard.
3. Applicant must have been active in community service or an organizational activity. No specific criterion is established, but greater consideration is given for greater depth of involvement/participation. Highest consideration is given for someone who acted in a leadership capacity or led the initiation of a significant new activity. Applicants will need to identify/specify this on their application.
4. In the absence of community service, an applicant can receive similar consideration if one of the following applies:
 - a. The applicant had a minimum of community service because they were highly active in a school activity other than sports such as DECA, Student Council, Arts, etc. In such an instance, the applicant should state how they contributed to the betterment of that activity.
 - b. The applicant had a minimum of community service because it was necessary for them to maintain after school employment. In such an instance, the applicant should state how this employment contributes to their preparation for college, either from a financial standpoint or a maturity/experience standpoint.
5. The strongest applicants will have met more than the minimum playing/refereeing time while having the strongest record of community service. (However, more community service is more important than more seasons.)

Scholarship Applicants should complete the application and submit it to the King Philip High School Guidance Office or if not from KPHS send to King Philip Soccer Association, P.O. Box 149, Norfolk, MA 02056 by April 1st.
