MASC/MASS Annual Conference

On November 8th, School Committee Chair Jim Lehan and myself attended the first day of the annual [MASC/MASS](#) (Massachusetts Association of School Committees/ Massachusetts Association of School Superintendents) Joint Conference in Hyannis. We attended a session together titled, "Unique Challenges of Regional Schools." After that, Mr. Lehan presented as a School Committee Chair along with a handful of superintendents as part of a panel session titled, "Getting the Message Right During a Crisis." Mr. Lehan presented extremely well and his words of wisdom were very well received by the session attendees!

Strategic Planning

Over the course of the past month, I have spoken to, met with, and got proposals from three vendors, who all have a good track record with facilitating district strategic planning work in school districts. I met with representatives from the following vendors: Teaching & Learning Alliance (TLA), Hazard Young Attea Associates (HYA), and District Management Group (DMGroup). After reviewing scope of work and cost proposals, checking their references with some superintendent colleagues who have utilized their services, and meeting with representatives from each company, we've decided to partner with TLA to help us facilitate King Philip Regional School District's next Strategic

Plan. As part of this work, we will next have an initial meeting with the organization's leaders, followed up with strategic planning meetings. In addition, there will be 3-5 forum meetings with King Philip school district stakeholders, development and implementation of a quantitative survey for us to collect data to be used in the strategic planning process, planning time to analyze that data and collaborate further with our district leadership team, and then develop the strategic plan with a professional layout and design. If needed, TLA can come give an overview of the strategic planning process at a School Committee meeting this winter.




Fall Sports Playoffs and Fall Student Signing Day
